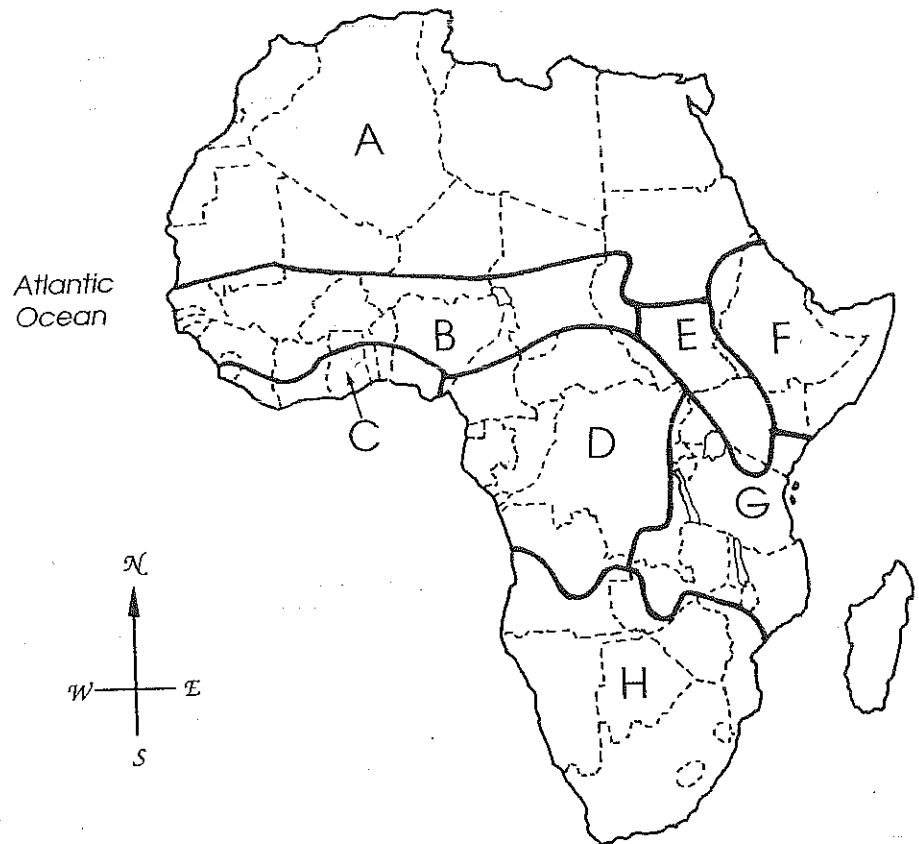

Cultural Area	People	Economic Activities
Northern Africa	Berbers Arabs	<b>Crops</b> – grains, citrus fruit, olives, vegetables, cereal, cotton, date palms <b>Other</b> – reserves of oil, natural gas, and water
Sudan	Susu, Mandingo, Beja, Nubian, Fulani, Wolofs	<b>Crops</b> – vegetables, fruit, cereal <b>Other</b> – metalworking, leather goods, trading, herds of cattle and camels
Guinea Coast	Ashanti, Fon, Ewe, Ibo, Yoruba	<b>Crops</b> – taro, cassava, rice, maize, yams, bananas <b>Other</b> – metalworking, raising pigs, chickens
Congo Basin	Bantu-speakers, Bambuti (Pygmies), Mongo, Bakongo, Baluba, Bena, Lulua, Tetela	<b>Crops</b> – cassava <b>Other</b> – metalworking, woodworking, copper and gold mining, hunting
Upper Nile	Nilotes (Nuer, Dinka), Shilluk	<b>Crops</b> – millet, maize, sesame, beans, pumpkins <b>Other</b> – herds of cattle, sheep, goats
Eastern Horn	Galla, Amhara, Konso, Sidamo, Afar, Somali	<b>Crops</b> – cotton, barley, sorghum, millet <b>Other</b> – herds of cattle, sheep, goats, salt mining, myrrh, frankincense
Eastern Africa	Watusi, Masai, Kikuyu, Chagga, Swahili	<b>Crops</b> – cereals, fruit, tea, sisal, coffee, bananas, beans, corn <b>Other</b> – herds of cattle
Southern Africa	Bushmen, Hottentots, Bantu, Zulu, Swazi, Sotho, Shona, Thonga	<b>Crops</b> – grains, vegetables, fruit <b>Other</b> – herds of horses, cattle, and sheep, diamond and gold mining
